

ITEC Programme at NIBM gets Overwhelming response

International Programme on Banking and Finance with special focus on Credit Management and International Trade Finances sponsored by Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation Programme (ITEC), was inaugurated by Dr K L Dhingra, Director, National Institute of Bank Management, at its campus in Pune. The two-week duration training programme commenced from March 2nd and will conclude on March 14, 2020. In his inaugural address to the participants, Dr Dhingra highlighted the importance of the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation Programme (ITEC), present banking scenario of the Indian banking industry and various activities of NIBM. In all, there are 38 participants from 18 different countries viz. Afghanistan, CIS countries, Middle East, SAARC countries, Southeast Asia, Africa, and South American region. By the end of current financial year, NIBM expects to train more than 1100 foreign participants which will be highest number so far.
