

NIBM may reserve seats for foreigners

THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE of Bank Management (NIBM) is evaluating the possibility of reserving some seats for overseas students or participants for its banking courses. KL Dhingra, director, NIBM, said that there has been a demand from neighbouring countries including Nepal and Bhutan to admit their students. The institute that will celebrate its golden jubilee in September this year has built up a reputation in the banking sector both in the country and overseas, he said. Some 1,064 participants from 52 countries took part in the various training sessions held by the institute.
